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Practicing Your Solo Breaks

This page has links to play-along tunes with solo breaks. The Break Locations indicate the bar numbers where the solo breaks occur in the tune form.

Each tune has two versions: in the first version, the drums keep time during the fills; in the second version (Silent Breaks), the drums drop out on each break, so you're on your own.

<u>All of Mia, Medium, 2-bar breaks</u> * <u>Silent Breaks</u>	Odd choruses: 3-4, 7-8, 11-12, etc	Even choruses: 1-2, 5-6, 9-10, etc
<u>Blue Boss, Medium, 4-bar breaks</u> * <u>Silent Breaks</u>	Odd choruses: 1-4, 9-12	Even choruses: 5-8, 13-16
