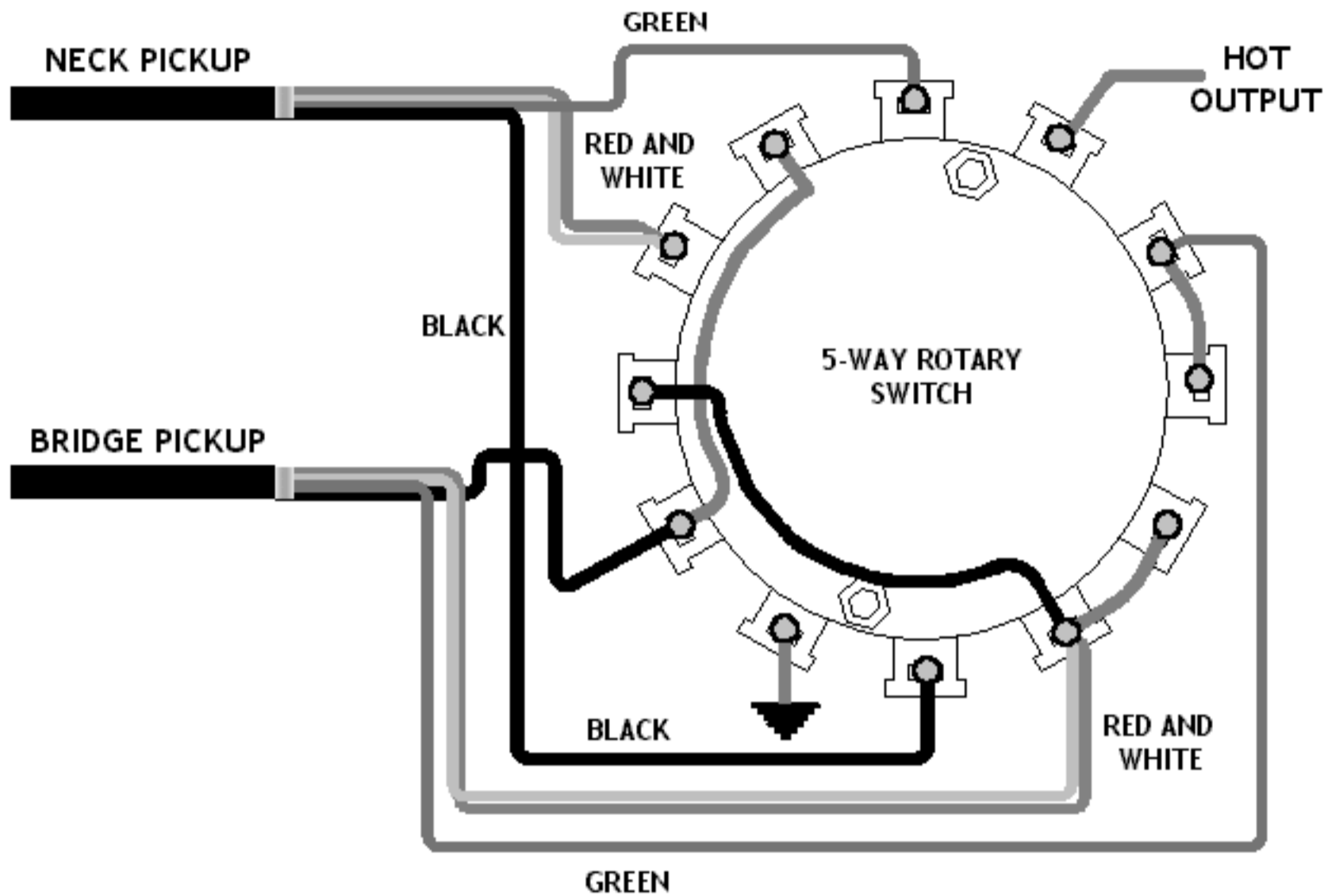


GROUND SYMBOL; ANY TIME YOU SEE THIS SYMBOL ATTACHED TO A WIRE, THAT WIRE NEEDS TO BE SOLDERED TO GROUND (Ground points are usually soldered to the back of the volume or tone pots or to any central ground point on the guitar; The central ground usually comes from a wire attached to the bridge of the guitar)

SOLDER POINT SYMBOL; THIS SYMBOL REPRESENTS THE PLACE AT WHICH TO SOLDER THE WIRE(S) TO THEIR CONTACT POINTS



NOTE:

THE MAGNET IN THE BRIDGE PICKUP MUST BE REVERSED IN ORDER TO ACHIEVE THE ACCURATE SWITCHING OPTIONS. TO REVERSE THE MAGNET, YOU MUST REMOVE THE BOTTOM PLATE FROM THE PICKUP AND TURN THE MAGNET OVER 180 DEGREES

5-WAY ROTARY 'PRS' TYPE CONVERSION WITH SEYMOUR DUNCAN PICKUPS

THIS DIAGRAM IS FOR USE WITH AN EXISTING PRE-WIRED SWITCH

USING A STANDARD 5-WAY ROTARY SWITCH, THIS IS YOUR SWITCHING PATTERN:

- POSITION 1 BRIDGE HUMBUCKER
- POSITION 2 OUTSIDE COILS PARALLEL
- POSITION 3 INSIDE COILS SERIES
- POSITION 4 INSIDE COILS PARALLEL
- POSITION 5 NECK HUMBUCKER
